Campers will further develop their audition skills, character development, script study, and theater discipline. Workshops and rehearsals throughout each day will challenge young actors to take risks, build relationships onstage, and learn more about themselves through theater expression. Campers will also learn about backstage and technical aspects of performing arts. This camp offers an in-depth study of how an actor fits into the whole process of developing a play with a fun, public performance at the end of the week.*
